CALL TO ACTION:

- 1) COLOR GUARD / HONOR GUARD We are looking for squared away cadets/leaguers.
 - This is a great opportunity and a lot of fun
 - Contact PO1 Aguilar if you are interested.
- 2) **PRT** Nows the time to start exercising for the PRT. If you have any questions on your individual requirements contact your Company Commander. IF YOU DO NOT DO THE PRT YOU WILL NOT GO TO SUMMER TRAINING!!!
- 3) **DRESS WHITE HANGER INSPECTION** To prepare for summer everyone should bring in their Dress White Uniforms on a hanger for inspection on SUNDAY 14 APRIL 2019.
 - Before you come inspect the uniform yourself and notify your CC of any discrepancies **BEFORE** the drill weekend.
 - This includes check for fit, missing patches and/or uniform items.
 - As discussed after the Dress Blue Inspection, the quicker we can get everyone squared away the more training we can do in and out of the center.
 - Cadets MUST BE AT DRILL to exchange dress whites and it MUST be this drill weekend ON SUNDAY ONLY.
 - CADETS MUST BRING IN THEIR OLD UNIFORMS TO BE EXCHANGED FOR NEW UNIFORMS
- 4) COURSEWORK Be sure to bring your courses to work on during the weekend. The next few months will be busy and you need your courses to do training and get advanced.
 - If you have any questions about how/where to find your courses contact your Company Commander / Chain of Command
 - You are permitted to bring your laptop to use when we work on coursework
- 5) **CHAIN OF COMMAND:** Everyone should be using their COC!
 - No one should be contacting the CO/XO/CPO's etc. without first going through their COMPANY COMMANDERS!
 - If you have any questions about your COC contact your COMPANY COMMANDERS via GroupMe.
 - If you can not reach them then contact Chief Bloess via GroupMe.

NOTES

- 1) ATTENDANCE Your attendance will be reviewed quarterly instead of annually. NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC/NLCC.
 - Notify your COMPANY COMMANDERS if you will be attending drill or not.
 - CADETS MUST HAVE ID CARDS ON HAND AT ALL TIMES WHEN AT THE NOSC.
- 2) CHOW The cost of chow is \$20.00 for Saturday and Sunday April 13 and April 14.
 - Cadets who are attending the **BOATING CLASS** are required to bring their own **CHOW**.
 - Please notify your COMPANY COMMANDERS if you will bring Chow or pay for Chow. If you have a Food Allergy you must bring your own food to drill.
- 3) ID CARDS AND ENROLLMENT FEES If you do not have a valid ID card you will not be allowed access to the NOSC. If it is expired you will not be allowed to attend drill. If your ID card expires you must renew your ID card by bringing a money order to drill in the amount of \$ 225.00. MUST HAVE ID CARDS!!!! PLEASE INFORM YOUR COMPANY COMMANDER IF IT IS EXPIRED.
 - If your ID Card EXPIRES before JUNE you must renew it in order to attend SUMMER TRAINING
 - PARENTS can bring blank checks to drill or pay online PARENTS SHOULD CONTACT THE PARENT COORDINATOR IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS!!
- 4) PT GEAR ALL CADETS are required to have the proper PT Gear. ALL CADETS are required to bring running shoes for PT. Wearing expensive footwear is highly advised against. MUST BRING DEODORANT!!!!!!
- 5) COURSEWORK BRING COURSEWORK FOR RATE. COURSE WORK can be located on the Divisions Website under: *Forms and Links*.
- 6) UNIFORMS ALL CADETS are expected to wear the proper uniform to drill. We are one division and we dress in one uniform. On the POM, the first uniform listed next to "Cadets:" is the uniform you arrive in. The other uniforms are to be brought in your sea bag. All information regarding uniforms is on the division website. Employ a certain level of respect when handling and wearing your uniforms. Brave men and women have fought and died in them.
